Per Walter, Senator Thompson obtained a legislative grant from the State of Florida for \$250,000 for improvements to the Wells' House (not the museum or casino). The intent is to open a store on the first floor, with office on the second. Rhodes+Brito is the lead designer.

Walter also mentioned that Senator Thompson and Commissioner Hill were coordinating with Orlando City Soccer to discuss the closure of Parramore Ave, but he did not have a lot of information to share yet.
